Official Launch of Wandusoa Organic Cameroon Pilot Project.

Thanks to the financial sponsorship of **Earth Rising Foundation** with energy and fiscal sponsorship of **The Pollination Project**, we had a very successful beginning. Beneficiaries, Parents, staff, traditional and administrative authorities took part in the official launch of our Pilot Project entitle: **“Preserve and Restore Topsoil in Cameroon”**. This event took place on the 25th February 2023 at Ekekam III village in the Lekie Division in the Center Region of Cameroon. Our nine-months training program is designed to train and equip marginalized youths (especially female school drop-outs) with regenerative agriculture/business skills so that they become socially, and ecologically responsible rural entrepreneurs. Eight beneficiaries began this journey in January 2023. Wandusoa left its doors opened to receive participants for our pilot project up till the end of the month of February.
