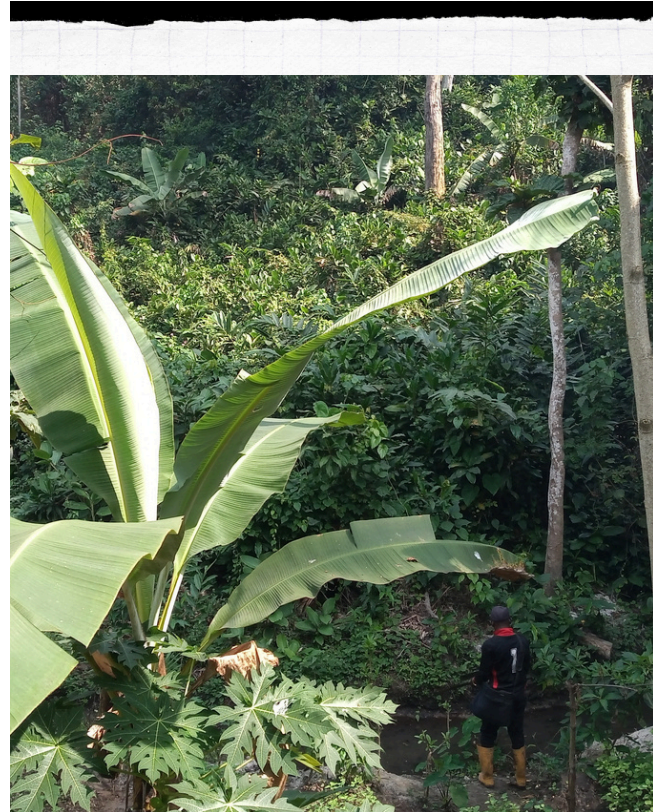
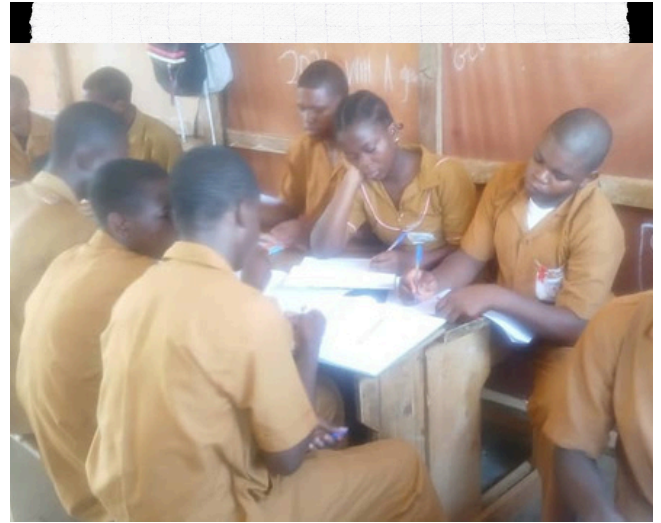
A HISTORIC MILESTONE: CAMEROON'S FIRST STUDENT-LED REGENERATIVE AGRIBUSINESS

This quarter, we launched our 4th cohort —a pioneering program empowering 20 internally displaced girls from conflict-affected regions in Northwest and Southwest Cameroon.

Key Highlights:

- ✔ Scholarships: 4 girls sponsored by [Kwanda](#) (learn more about their support here)
- ✔ Business Plan Success: Completed with guidance from 3 dedicated teachers via the Teach A Man To Fish UK's School Enterprise Challenge
- ✔ 2026 Launch: Growing and selling spinach and huckleberries, while gaining 21st-century skills like financial literacy, leadership, and climate-smart agriculture
- ✔ Triple Impact: Profit generation, employment creation, and community resilience
