### WANDUSOA GRADUATES SECOND BATCH OF REGENERATIVE FARMERS.

Wandusoa has graduated its second batch of regenerative farmers. The nine-month intensive regenerative business and farming training took place in the Wandusoa Food Forest in Saxenhof-Wotutu. The training, which consisted of six months of training and three months of mentorship, concluded this October with the successful graduation of 10 regenerative farmers from our regenerative agriculture school in 2024.

Introducing Ma So, a dedicated Wandusoa alumna from the inaugural 2023 cohort. Ma So, a trailblazing pioneer beneficiary, manages a 12-hectare farmland where she cultivates a diverse range of food crops, including cocoa and plantains. Her success serves as a testament to the potential of our community-based project's expansion.
