WANDUSOA GRADUATES FIRST BATCH OF REGENERATIVE FARMERS



Dear friends and supporters of Wandusoa, We express our sincere gratitude for your generous support in our pilot project between January 2023 and October 2023. Special thanks go to Earth Rising Foundation and The Pollination Project Greenhouse Grant for the scholarship offered to train vulnerable youths in regenerative agriculture business in our 6-month training and 3-month mentorship course. It was a huge start for Wandusoa. We graduated 10 regenerative farmers in our first year of Operation. Eight of our graduates are now running their regenerative farm businesses and two have gained formal employment in Wandusoa as Farm Assistants.
